Carrie Tomlinson, City of Edmond arborist, has assisted us in having <u>three hazardous trees removed in our</u> <u>addition</u>. A big thank-you to the City of Edmond Hazardous Tree Removal program!

Each year the City of Edmond designates funds for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) purposes. At the end of each fiscal year, the City releases any remaining funds for special projects. We are pleased to announce that the City of Edmond has approved funds to <u>install ADA approved sidewalks at both</u> <u>entrances</u> of our addition. Look for the City to be working at both entrances within the next couple of months. A big thank-you to the City of Edmond!!

Through the Sidewalk Partnership Program (SPP), the <u>City will be replacing sidewalks on the North</u> <u>Bryant entrance and near the City of Edmond Park</u>. The HOA will only bear 30% of the cost of this improvement, thanks to the City of Edmond SPP. The BC is working on a <u>comprehensive beautification plan</u> for our addition. This plan will include replacing street lights; tree maintenance and replacement along the frontages; possible additions of shrubs and ornamental to the frontages, continued improvements to the entrances and further development of our City Park.
