Treasurer's Report

As of July 19, 2018, the HOA has collected \$19,175 in 2018 dues. This equates to 57% homeowners paying dues. The Board approved additional funds for the scheduled Fall Event and for Fall and Christmas Decorations. Other expenses are on track with budgeted projections. Capital Improvement expenses are reflected below. No other fence replacement is expected this year. Currently, a \$3,360.11 balance remains in the reserve fund. Based on dues received to date, the HOA has \$6,115.73 available to pay the remaining projected expenses and make reserve fund contributions for 2018.
