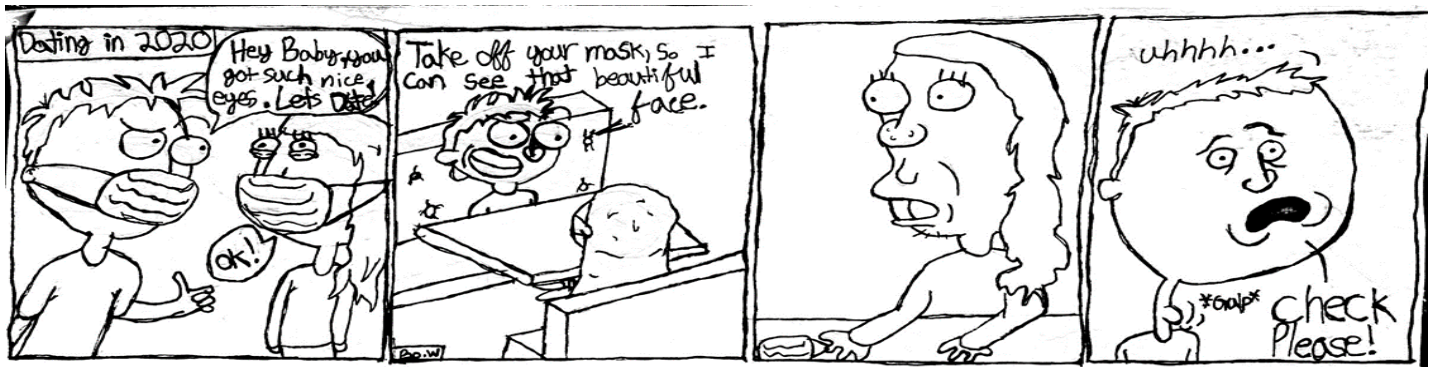

For those that may accept cash, paying with a card by choice will help limit your contact. We recommend it!
